Attention, if you are sick during your holidays, do not forget to follow the letter, the procedure of the medical service ... (The deadline for sending the certificate is shorter (48 hours)!

Here is the information to transmit to the medical service:

- ✓ Your name and last name
- ✓ Your personnal ID number
- ✓ The dates of the beginning and the end of the illness and the annual leave
- ✓ The exact address of your place of residence during your period of absence
- ✓ Your contact details (phone / mobile number, fax, address, e-mail, etc.)
- ✓ The name, address and contact information of your doctor.

It is therefore very important to bring all the necessary documents with you and keep these links in your favorites!





BACK TO SCHOOL VS END OF STUDY

As every year, you will be invited soon to introduce a new school declaration if your child continues his studies.

We would like to remind you of the importance of introducing your declaration as soon as possible to avoid any problem in the payment of family allowances (cuts, recovery ...).

In the same way, if your child has decided to stop his studies and he has not yet reached the age of 26, you must inform the PMO so as not to improperly collect family allowances ...

These improperly collected amounts will be claimed later and could represent significant amounts!

(See our point on the application of Article 85 of the Staff Regulations)

What if your child works while studying?

This can have an impact on family allowances. Its income must not exceed 40% of the basic salary of an AST 1/1 (ie AST $1/1 = 2921.30 \in -> 40\% = 1168.52 \in$).

Note that this does not apply to "student jobs".



ANNUAL TRAVEL EXPENSES

As every year, as long as you open the right to these travel expenses, these will be paid on the June salary.

To open the right to travel expenses, your place of origin must be more than 200km from your duty station and you must be entitled to the expatriation or expatriation allowance (4% or 16%).

Depending on your family situation, you may also be able to collect annual travel expenses for your family members.

Note that for contract and temporary agents, annual travel expenses are paid only after completing 9 months of activity.

To know or verify the amount, you can use the calculator available on MyIntracomm (updated each year)

Note that pensioners no longer open the right to the expatriation / expatriation allowance, they no longer collect annual travel expenses, once pensioner.

ACQUISITION of a new nationality

Please note that if, for example, you are assigned to Brussels and wish to obtain Belgian nationality, you must be aware that this will have consequences on your annual travel expenses as well as your allowances.

By acquiring Belgian nationality, you will lose the benefit of your expatriation allowance or expatriation allowance, as well as your annual travel expenses.

SFE, who shared his experience with the colleagues present, is pleased that the meeting took place in a constructive and supportive atmosphere.




